

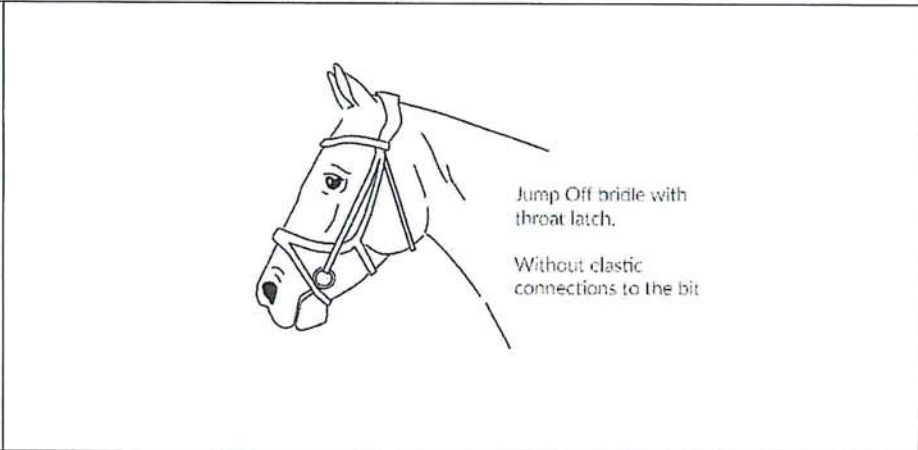

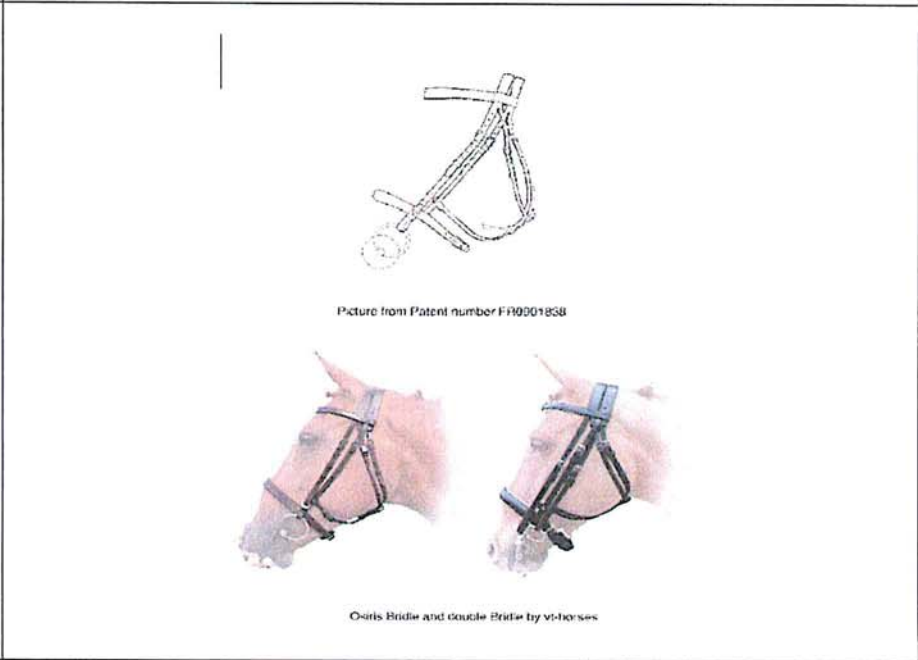

PS of Sweden Jump Off bridle






